LOOKING TO VOLUNTEER FOR THE STEUBENVILLE SOUTH CONFERENCE?

We use the term "Door Holder," borrowed from Psalm 84:10, which speaks of being a doorkeeper in the house of God.

Volunteering at the Steubenville South Youth Conference is an exceptional opportunity to make a difference in the lives of teens and to experience a spiritually fulfilling and uniquely Catholic volunteer opportunity. Come and see first hand-hand the power of the Holy Spirit at work in our youth!

We are in need of approximately 100 volunteers to make everything run smoothly for this year's Steubenville South Conference weekend. Help is needed in a variety of areas - see below for descriptions of each. Volunteers must be at least 21 years of age, and complete a Volunteer Application (at steubenvillesouth.com), and Code of Conduct form, signed by themselves and their pastor. - Catering: Provide assistance to conference participants by preparing and serving meals, directing the food line, and keeping the area clean. This area does not necessarily require cooking skills.
- Confessions: Assist teens and adults as they wait in line in preparation to participate in the sacrament of reconciliation.
- First Aid: Attend to the health and well being of participants. Volunteers serving in First Aid must have some type of medical certification, but minimally First Aid/CPR. Typical items treated include dehydration, headache, and minor cuts.
- Liturgy: Assist our priests and stage crew volunteers in the set up and take down of all materials for Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament throughout the conference weekend.
- Marketplace: Assist participants in purchasing items that will aid them in their faith journey and remind them of their conference experience. Responsibilities may include set up or tear down of the Marketplace area, pricing, displaying merchandise, stocking, inventory, and managing registers.
- Prayer Ministry: Must have attended a Prayer Ministry training. Pray for the ministry of the conference office before, during, and after the event. Assist Group Leaders with the prayer needs of participants during the conference. Keep the focus on Jesus Christ throughout the weekend.
- Security: Keep order around the conference site. Ensure that all participants are in appropriate areas and are accompanied by adult chaperones. Patrol the event area to ensure rules are followed for the safety of all.
- Stage Crew: Assist in the setup and transition of stage items for each session. Assist with environment, as needed in all interior conference session areas.
- Ushers: Maintain an orderly flow of participants in session rooms. Help direct people to seating, keep fire lanes clear, distribute materials, and monitor traffic flow during sessions.
